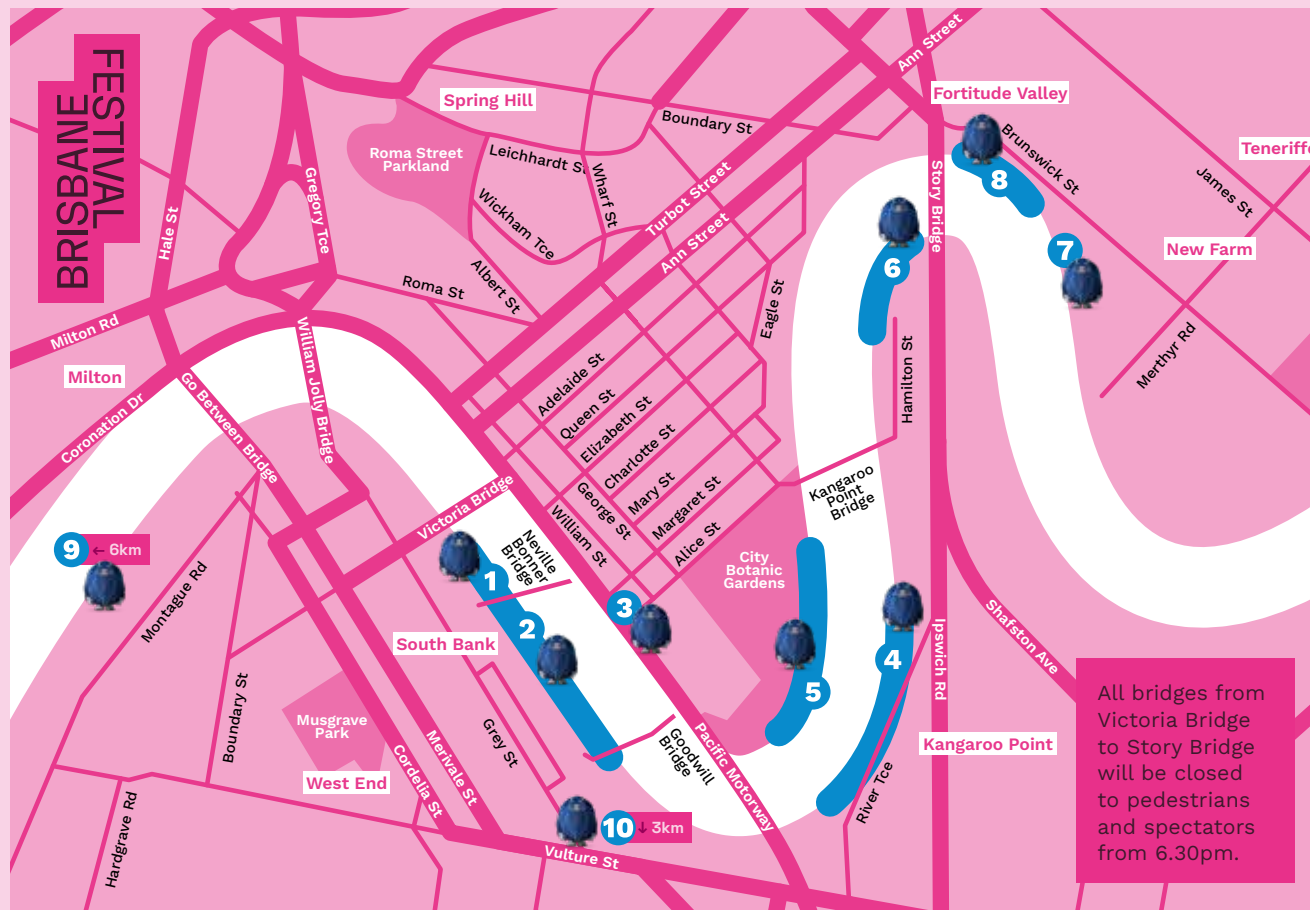

1 Verso Projects. Festival Village, South Bank

The beating heart of Brisbane Festival, alive with an ever-changing program of free and ticketed events from first light to after dark.

2 South Bank

The heart of the action and the place to be for those who want to get close to the celebration.

3 Queen's Wharf Brisbane

Across the Neville Bonner Bridge there are riverside parks and spots to watch the display.

4 Kangaroo Point Cliffs

Breathtaking, elevated views over the Brisbane River, making the cliffs one of the most popular places to see the fireworks.

5 City Botanic Gardens

A classic spot with a beautiful riverside setting. The gardens are set to glow under the lights once again.

6 Captain Burke Park

Located beneath the Story Bridge, this park offers a cosy and intimate setting for enjoying the display close to the river.

7 Wilson Outlook Reserve

A smaller but elevated vantage point with stunning views of the Story Bridge and the city skyline.

8 Howard Smith Wharves

Home to Felon's Brewing Co., the riverside location boasts many dining options and spectacular views.

9 Mt Coot-tha Lookout

For one of the highest vantage points in Brisbane, Mt Coot-tha Lookout offers panoramic views of the fireworks display. Before the fireworks, take some time to explore the nearby Botanic Gardens.

10 Highgate Hill Park

Enjoy the fireworks from this heritage-listed site that offers a fantastic vantage point over the city.
